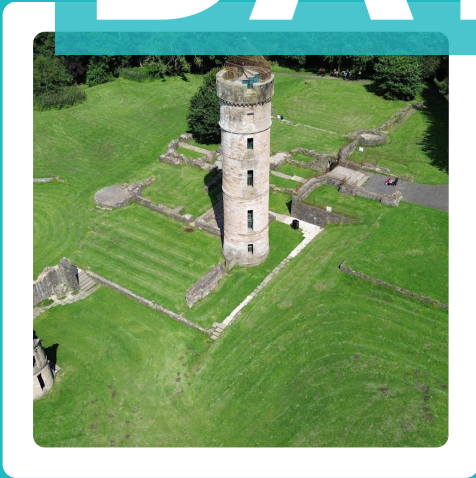
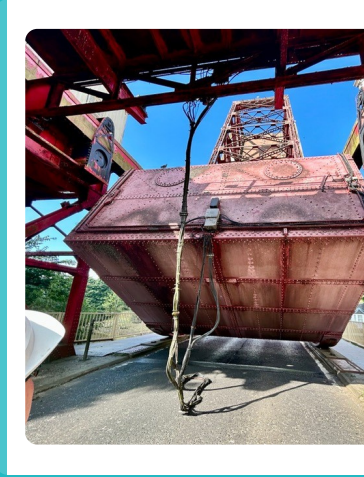


DOORS OPEN DAYS 2023

Across the country doors were opened wide, welcoming locals to uncover hidden gems and revisit familiar places through fresh eyes.

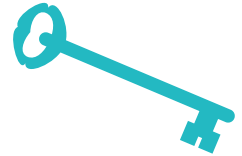
